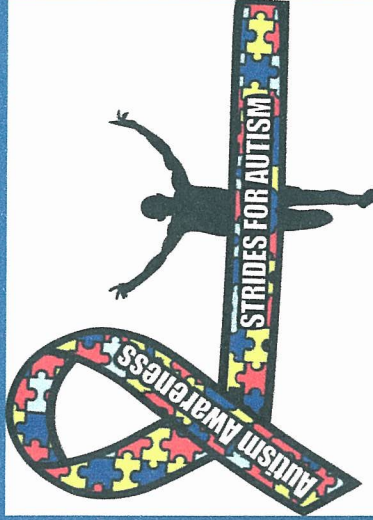

Strides for Autism is a 5K Run/Walk through the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind Campus. The event is created and hosted by ten Flagler College students in Facility & Event Management course to spread community Autism awareness and advocacy ,and raise funds to support Autism research and those families and their children personally affected by this developmental disability. The event features anticipated VIP visits from Project Autism's founder Troy Blevins and Bethany Burnette, who will sing the national anthem, and is a young woman who has overcome autism to reach her dreams and sing at the White House. Runners of all ages are welcome. However, an adult must accompany children at all times. Various viewing stations and activities will be set-up along the course for supports to watch and enjoy this family friendly day. Food and water will be provided to runners and walkers free of cost. All others may enjoy the same raceday beverages and food with a donation. Children's activities and games will complete the festivities along with a raffle and award ceremony.
